A full range to meet all requirements at Prodex'08

Tornos is presenting its expertise through a very wide range of solutions at the Prodex 2008 trade fair (from 18 to 22 November) in Basle. The range of products has been very significantly expanded in order to meet all customer requirements. Stand A16 in hall 1.0 will be a must-see for anyone involved in the bar turning sector. From the most straightforward to the most complex parts with diameters ranging from 1 to 32mm in all price brackets, the Swiss manufacturer can offer machines adapted to the needs of a wide variety of industries.

On the stand: first and foremost, very high precision

The Micro 8 will be producing parts for the watchmaking sector and the Micro 7 will be making parts for the connector industry with the visitors getting the opportunity to "touch the micron." The two complementary products, one working with a guide bush and the other without, were a resounding success in Switzerland in 2007-2008, meeting the needs of the watchmaking industry. In many cases, the need for secondary operation re-work has been removed!

Precise customization to meet customer requirements

In the 13mm machine category, the two 'a' and 'e' Decos will be producing parts from the medical and watchmaking sectors to demonstrate the very high level of flexibility the Deco 13 can offer. The difference between the two models is the number of tool systems available. Integrating both machines in an existing park is straightforward, the philosophy the same, tools and tool holders are interchangeable, even the programming is similar. For companies making use of complex machines for turning straightforward parts, the Deco 'e' range offers an excellent opportunity to take some of the workload off 'a' machines. This way, users can work with machines that are perfectly suited to the parts to be turned.

Expansion towards entry level solutions

In the more straightforward machine category, Tornos offers two lines, the Delta and Sigma. On the stand at Prodex, visitors have the opportunity to discover the Sigma 20 II fitted with six axes (or eight with axis c) and mixed TB Deco/ISO programming. This machine enables straightforward manufacturing of medium-complexity parts.

Concerning the Delta range that was warmly received at Siams this year, Tornos will be exhibiting a 20mm five-axis machine. This range comprises six machines with 3, 4 and 5 axes for maximum capacities of 12mm and 20mm. The model presented is the most fully equipped in the Delta range.

A range to satisfy all requirements

Parts turned on the exhibited machines come from nearly all the main sectors for whom Tornos proposes a solution, including watchmaking, medical, electronics and high-precision. As far as the automotive sector and multi-spindle machines are concerned, Tornos is unveiling its Virtual multi system for the very first time. This new method of presenting in virtual reality comes into its own for multi-spindle machines, which are highly complex by nature. This procedure will enable visitors to journey right to the heart of the multi-spindles.
